Advent and The Walk to Emmaus

The "Walk to Emmaus" gets it name from Luke 24:13-35 recounting the story of Jesus' appearance to two disciples walking form Jerusalem to Emmaus. Listen to Him!

In a neighborhood in Bethlehem there was a lot of commotion in a neighbor's stable one night, strange lights, muffled voices, and then a baby's cry pierced the darkness. It was a plaintive, powerful cry for one so young.

Some 20 centuries later, many people think little more of Christmas than that, a lot of noise about the birth of a child. Much of the noise is unfocused noise that muffles the voice of Jesus. Children are chattering about this year's sensational toy. Hollywood is barking over its year-end offerings. And Wall Street is whining that we haven't spent enough this season. We live with this noise without taking stock of its spiritual toll.

The season of Advent is upon us. The Christmas clamor will soon begin to rise in our ears. The word *advent* is instructive. It means "coming." God Himself is coming. He comes with a message of Good News.

Perhaps it would be good to think of Advent less as a season of preparation and more as a season of receiving, or listening. God is the speaker. We are the listeners. We hear what God has to say through the Word and Sacraments. The tradition of adding a midweek service during Advent makes sense then. It is not just another obligation. It is an opportunity to listen to Him.

Of course, no one knows how much noise the newborn baby Jesus actually made. We do know that when the Word became flesh, He came to speak Good News of forgiveness in His name. During the season of Advent we prepare for His coming as we listen to Him. -- Rev. Terry Forke, LCMS Montana District

Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group Board of Directors Meeting

The Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group Board of Directors met on Thursday, November 5, 2009 at Northwest Hills United Methodist Church. In attendance were: Gene McConnell – Assistant Lay Director; Bob Duplantis – Member Support; Sandy Brooks – Gathering Support; Diane Merwarth – Walk Support; Roxie Greenway – Treasurer; Pastor Georgia Stone – Spiritual Director; Leslie Smith – Immediate Past Lay Director. Also present: Joan King – Lay Director of Walk 1530.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM by Gene McConnell, with an opening prayer by Bob Duplantis. The minutes of the previous Board Meeting were approved as written by a motion by Diane Merwarth, seconded by Bob Duplantis. The finance report was given by Roxie Greenway, and was approved by a motion from Bob Duplantis with a second from Sandy Brooks. Ending balance as of 10/31/09 is \$4,933.66.

Joan King gave a report of Walk 1530, held October 22 – 25, 2009 at Highland Lakes Baptist Encampment. She reported having 25 pilgrims; one pilgrim (not included in the 25) became ill and was unable to complete the walk. The Welcome Back, held October 29, 2009 at St. Mark United Methodist Church was also very successful, with participation of many pilgrims and team. One safety issue was raised regarding the lack of lighting along one part of the path on the way to Candlelight. A reminder will be given to the Servant Team to ensure flashlights will be made available to light this section of the path.

Discussion of the "Mysignup" agape process determined that it was a successful endeavor, to be continued for the next walk. One suggestion which has been implemented was to organize the items by category.

Another follow up from Walk 1530 was mailing of a letter from the Board to welcome each new pilgrim and invite them to participate in GAE4thDG. This is intended to become a routine communication after each walk.

Sandy Brooks reported that host churches for 2010 Gatherings are being identified. Two churches are pending confirmation for January and February (The Rock and Crestview UMC respectively), and hosts for March and April are confirmed (Hyde Park UMC and Riverbend, respectively).

Discussion of the HLCCC contract and the search for alternative walk sites is ongoing.

The Board's efforts to revitalize the Emmaus community and recruitment of sponsors and Pilgrims continues.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:00 PM with a closing prayer by Pastor Georgia Stone. Minutes submitted by:
