The general format at the web site is a list of instructions at the top of the page, followed by a grid of 6 columns with many rows for the items needed. The list of items is in alphabetical order. If you want to search for a particular item, you can enter <Control-F>, enter the name in the Find box, and press the Next button.

Approximately one week prior to the beginning of a Walk, a reminder e-mail will be sent to you for each item that you have promised to bring. The drop-off locations will be listed in the reminder e-mail.

Pentecost Power for Our Witness

Yearly we observe Pentecost 50 days after Easter. The story seems strange, with the crowded room, the rushing wind; the tongues of fire, people from many nations hearing the disciples speak in their native languages. What does it mean for us?

Jesus' words give meaning to the event: "You will be My witnesses" (Acts 1:8). Since Jesus will soon ascend into heaven, He intends for the apostles to proclaim the Good News in word and deed. They are to bear witness to the ends of the earth. What a challenge! The disciples were confused, weak, afraid -- wavering in their witness.

The purpose of Pentecost remains for us. We are His witnesses in our own homes, next door, at work, in our community, and throughout the world. Big job. And we hesitate, rationalize, stumble, fear -- wavering in our witness.

For that reason God makes available to us the power of Pentecost. The disciples were emboldened to bear witness. Uneducated, sinful, afraid, the Holy Spirit transforms them into unashamed witnesses who cannot but speak the things that they have heard and seen -- in the temple, before the council, in the synagogues. Pentecost power in the Word of God.

We also receive God's Pentecost power. Looking to the crucified and risen one, and convicted of our sins, we repent and believe the Gospel. We cannot help but speak and live the things we have heard and seen through God's Word.

Thank you, Father, for the outpouring of Your Holy Spirit in that first Pentecost. Pour out Your Spirit through the Word so we may witness to Your Son, Jesus Christ, Amen.

Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group - Board of Directors Meeting

The Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group Board of Directors met on Thursday, April 7, 2011 at Crestview UMC. In attendance were: Gene McConnell – Lay Director; Bob Duplantis – Member Support; Diane Merwarth – Walk Support; Sandy Brooks – Assistant Lay Director; Roxie Greenway – Treasurer; Cheryl Broome, Spiritual Director; Jack Foreman, Past Lay Director; Kathy Robbins, Chrysalis Rep. and Tom Rioux.

The meeting was called to order at 6:03 PM by Gene McConnell. The minutes of the previous Board Meeting were approved as read by a motion by Bob Duplantis, seconded by Sandy Brooks.

The treasurer's report was presented by Roxie Greenway and was approved unanimously upon a motion by Jack Foreman with a second from by Bob Duplantis. There is a balance of \$4136.96 available in the account.

Bob Duplantis moved that we write off the \$100 due to Greater Austin Emmaus from the Southwest Conference and the \$146.25 in team fees that is believed to be uncollectible. Seconded by Gene McConnell and passed.

Roxie Greenway reported that we have our federal ID number for Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group. The name on the GAE4DG checking account has been changed from Southwest Texas Conference Greater Austin Emmaus to Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group.

Jack Foreman and Gene McConnell will work toward a media kit and Sandy Brooks and Bob Duplantis will work on email list and communications. The Board approved \$500 for this purpose.

Jack Foreman, Gene McConnell and Sandy Brooks agreed to contact pilgrims' sponsors from walk 1607 to ask them to move to the fall walk.

Kathy Robbins reported that there will be a Chrysalis Hoot on April 29 at Dripping Springs UMC. The Girls Chrysalis Flight is scheduled for June 16-18, the Boys Flight is scheduled for July 28-30, and a Journey is scheduled for January 5-7.

Cheryl Broome will be looking at the 5th Day Retreat to see if this can be done within Emmaus.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:00. There were 72 in attendance at the gathering.
