As some of you may know, the first "Walk to Emmaus" events in Romania, Walk 1 is a men's walk and Walk 2 is a women's walk, will take place in the month of March. GAE4DG Kathy Shaw, current SWTX Lay Director, will be traveling to Romania to serve on those walks and taking agape from GAE4DG with her for the pilgrims of those walks. We have one more act of agape that we can give to those pilgrims and the teams serving on those walks, that is to sign up to pray for each of the walk.

Brothers and Sisters - we have an incredible opportunity to take part in a miracle coming to fruition. Twenty-four years ago the country of Romania was under the heavy fist of a particularly brutal Communist dictator. Today, they are getting ready to have their first-ever Walk to Emmaus events. And they desperately need our prayers.

## Agape Signup Online

**The signup for Men's Walk to Emmaus #1659 is:** [www.mysignup.com/walk1659agape](http://www.mysignup.com/walk1659agape)

The general format at the web site is a list of instructions at the top of the page, followed by a grid of 6 columns with many rows for the items needed. The list of items is in alphabetical order. If you want to search for a particular item, you can enter <Control-F>, enter the name in the Find box, and press the Next button.

Approximately one week prior to the beginning of a Walk, a reminder e-mail will be sent to you for each item that you have promised to bring. The drop-off locations will be listed in the reminder e-mail.

### A Clean Heart Create In Me

C.S. Lewis (1898-1963) ranks as one of the greatest Christian apologists of the 20th century. He had a keen eye for deception and muddled thinking. When it came to spiritual matters, he took on not only the outright atheist, but the lukewarm and halfhearted Christian. Here are some excerpts from his works for our Lententide.

**SOMETHING TO REPENT** -- Psalm 51:1-2

Christianity tells people to repent and promises them forgiveness. It therefore has nothing (as far as I know) to say to people who do not know they have done anything to repent of and who do not feel that they need any forgiveness. It is after you realized that there is a real Moral Law and a Power behind the Law; and that you have broken that law and put yourself wrong with that Power -- it is after all this, and not a moment sooner, that Christianity begins to talk.

**LOSS AND GAIN** -- Luke 9:23-24

The principle runs through all life from top to bottom. Give up yourself, and you will find your real self. Lose your life and you will save it. Submit to death, death of your ambitions and favorite wishes every day and death of your whole body in the end: submit with every fiber of your being, and you find eternal life. Keep back nothing. Nothing that you have not given away will ever be really yours. Nothing in you that has not died will ever be raised from the dead. Look for yourself, and you will find in the long run only hatred, loneliness, despair, rage, ruin, and decay. But look for Christ and you will find Him, and with Him everything else thrown in.

Lord Jesus, help me to remember that I will lose nothing of value by putting you first and foremost in my life.
