Dear brothers and sisters of the GAEC,


If you've never served on a Chrysalis, you don't know what you've been missing! Chrysalis is the Walk to Emmaus for high school youth. It takes its name from the growth process (or chrysalis) that a caterpillar goes through as it becomes a butterfly. This growth symbolizes each youth's transformation through Christ into the person God has called them to be. Chrysalis builds up young leaders in the church.

Historically, we have offered two Chrysalis flights every summer – one for boys and one for girls. During the summer of 2014, we want to start offering four flights every summer. To do this we need more men and women from the Austin area who are willing to serve on teams – including those with a desire to eventually serve as lay directors. This summer of 2013, we will have two flights for which we are selecting teams:

June 26-29 Girls Flight 367 in Victoria August 1-3 Boys Flight 375 in Victoria

It seems that half the fun of Christmas is looking forward to it. For a child it was a mind filled with wondering and dreaming of what awaited on Christmas morning. As an adult it's a little different. I look forward to seeing the expressions of excitement and happiness as family members open the presents I gave them.

The first Christmas, when the greatest gift of all was given, was marked by an anticipation that had stretched across the centuries. As a result of this promise, Simeon spent his days in the temple awaiting this promise and living in anticipation of the moment he would see the Messiah of Israel. *Simeon came in the Spirit into the temple; and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to carry out for Him the custom of the Law, then he took Him into his arms, and blessed God, and said, "Now Lord, You are releasing Your bondservant to depart in peace, according to Your word; for my eyes have seen Your salvation, which You have prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light of revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of Your people Israel."*

What a fantastic scene -- as Mary and Joseph watched a completely contented man do the most important thing he would ever do -- celebrate Jesus. May our celebration of the Christ be defined by the unique contentment of the heart that comes from knowing Him. De Colores! Gerard Kern

Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group - Board of Directors Meeting Tarrytown United Methodist Church Thursday, October 4, 2012

The following were in attendance: Gary Johnson-Lay Director; Anne Rioux-Asst. Lay Director; Cheryl Broome, Spiritual Director; Debby Duplantis-Treasurer; Tom Rioux-4th Day Board Representative; Sandy Brooks-Immediate Past Lay Director; Bobby Callison-Walk Support; and Tim Deschner, Austin Crossroads/Chrysalis Representative.

The meeting was called to order at 5:34 PM by Gary Johnson. Bobby Callison offered the opening prayer. The minutes from the September 2012 BOD meeting were read. Tom Rioux moved to accept the minutes, and Bobby Callison seconded the motion. The minutes were approved unanimously.

The Board discussed an email submitted by Bob Duplantis regarding signage to help the community get to Candlelights at Camp Young Judaea. One idea was to install balloons at the turn from Highway 12 and at Camp Young Judaea's sign near the entrance. Since Bob is the Servant Team Coordinator for upcoming Men's Walk #1686, he will determine what will work and report back his recommendations to the Board.

The Treasurer's report was reviewed. Debby Duplantis will transfer funds from the unencumbered funds to the scholarship fund to maintain a minimum \$500 balance for scholarships. She further requested approval to purchase a stamp for depositing checks into the GAE4DG bank account. Gary Johnson moved that Debby should do so, Tom Rioux seconded and the purchase was approved unanimously. Anne Rioux moved to accept the Treasurer's report, Bobby Callison seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Bobby Callison reported that as of October 4 there was no one in place for child care for the Candlelight for Walk #1686 in October. He has asked Pastor Dana Hamilton of Wimberley UMC to bring their child care personnel on board to cover Candlelights for us. Bobby reported that posters for marketing walks at other churches are pending. The Board discussed the ongoing issue of speaker microphones, as the speakers for Walk #1674 prefer lapel mics over the headphone mic. Bobby moved that the Board approve the purchase of a lapel or ear mic costing up to \$250; Tom Rioux seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Member Support-Tom Rioux reported that Jim Burgess is working with Bud Broeker on Yahoo access and email blasts.

The Board reviewed Tom Rioux's suggested Tips for Becoming a Lay Director and approved them subject to minor revisions and posting in the Walk Talk. Tom presented a list of proposed candidates for Lay Directors for the second half of 2013. The Board approved the list and Tom will proceed to contact the candidates. The Board reviewed documents Tom Rioux has drafted for Responsibilities for Walk Lay Directors, Board Representatives and Servant Team Coordinators.

Sandy Brooks advised that the GAE4DG revised bylaws are pending approval by the Southwest Texas Conference. Anne Rioux is deliberating about nominees for Assistant Lay Director and Gathering Support positions which will need to be filled June 2013. Cheryl Broome is working on nominees for the Spiritual Director position which will need to be filled June 2013.

Tim Deschner reported on upcoming 2013 Chrysalis Flights and Journeys. Women's' Journey #27 led by LD Cindy Becker, SD Leigh Lloyd-Gregg, and BR Ehrikka Hodge is scheduled at Twin Oaks on January 2-5. The Girls' Flight #367 is pending on June 26-29 and will be led by Stephanie Cortez at First UMC Victoria. There is a Boys' Flight #375 scheduled for August 1-3 led by Russell Kacer at First UMC Victoria. Tim will explore the financial needs for the 2013 weekends and advise the Board. He will submit an article to the Walk Talk regarding the need for August Lay Directors for two additional Flights in Austin. Tim is working with church Youth Directors to generate sign-ups for Flights.

The 2013 Walk dates are February 7-10 (Men's Walk #1690, LD George Tolleson, SD Monte Marshall, BR Jack Foreman, STC Kathy and Ted Shaw), May 2-5 (Women's Walk #1707, LD Susan Curtis, SD Judy Baskin, BR Diane Merwarth, STC Sherry Wilkison)

Other reports:

The 4th Day Speaker for the October Gathering is Cary Dietert.

Westlake UMC will host the November 1, 2012 Gathering.

Parker Lane UMC will host the December 6, 2012 Gathering.

First UMC Pflugerville will host the January 3, 2013 Gathering which will include the commissioning of the team for Walk 1690.

Additional dates for Gatherings for the first half of 2013 are February 14 (2nd Thursday), March 7, April 4, and May 9 (2nd Thursday).

Lee Leen Sundbeck and Roxie Greenway filed a report on Walk 1674. Cheryl Broome advised that Teri Sloan will present a proposal for speaker amps for future Conference Room Teams.

Bud Broeker has stepped down as database coordinator. Tom Rioux offered to assume the tasks. Gary Johnson nominated Tom for the job, Bobby Callison seconded the nomination and the Board approved Tom Rioux as database coordinator.

Cheryl Broome closed the meeting with prayer.

There were 124 people in attendance at the September 2012 Gathering.
