### Greater Austin Emmaus 4<sup>th</sup> Day Group Board of Directors' Monthly Meeting First UMC, Austin Thursday, May 1, 2014

**Opening:** The regular meeting of the GAE4DG Board was called and held on May 1<sup>st</sup> at First UMC commencing at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Anne Rioux. Present were: Anne Rioux, Lay Director; Mel Chambers, Assistant Lay Director; Gary Johnson, Immediate Past Lay Director; Tom Rioux, Board Representative to SWTC; Debby Duplantis, Treasurer; Bobby Callison, Board Member for Walk Support; Cheryl Broome, Spiritual Director; LeeLeen Sundbeck, Board Member for Gathering Support; Carl Fisher, Candidate for Board Member for Walk Support; Chris McKemie, Candidate for for Assistant Lay Director; David Graham, Lay Director for Men's Walk #1758; Susan Curtis, Lay Director for Women's Walk #1749; Diane Merwarth, Board Representative for Women's Walk #1749; Myles McKemie, Servant Team Coordinator for Women's Walk #1749. The opening prayer was given by Anne Rioux.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved.

**Treasurer's Report:** Debby Duplantis' treasurer's report informed us that there was no change in our financial status. Wallk #1749 closeout was completed and will be reflected on next month's report. The Board approved the report.

**SWTC Board Representative Report:** There was a Team Selection meeting for Walk #1775 at St. Mark's UMC on April 30<sup>th</sup> and the team was approved by the Board by email. Tom Rioux gave us a list of potential candidates for 2015 Walk Lay Directors.

**Gathering Support Report:** LeeLeen Sundbeck reported that we have a speaker for the June Gathering. All Gatherings between now and September are set and ready to go. The October Gathering needs a pastor and communion elements.

**Walk Support Report:** Bobby Callison reported that Welcome Back went well and the turnout was good. Two of the three young ladies approved for child care will be leaving for college, so we need to find replacements.

Members Services Report: Jim Burgess did not have anything new to report.

**Immediate Past Lay Director Report:** Gary Johnson had a handout with 501 (c) 3 with questions that needed to be answered. He is checking to see if we can go under SWTC 501 (c) 3.

Spiritual Director Report: Rev. Cheryl Broome has not found anyone to be her replacement.

**Chrysalis Representative Report:** Tim Deschner reported that Boys Chrysalis Flight #381, which was to begin July 17<sup>th</sup> at Covenant UMC, has been cancelled.

Walk #1758 Report: David Graham informed the Board that he has a full team but still needs a Spiritual Director. The first team meeting was a success.

**New/Other Business:** Bobby Callison and Gary Johnson volunteered to take care of the Silent Auction, Child Care, Cupcake Walk, and to supply greeters/ushers for Rev. Tina Carter at the June 7<sup>th</sup> Gathering. Anne Rioux will take care of getting items and people signed up for potluck and auction.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:45 p.m. by Anne Rioux. The next Board meeting will be at 6:00 p.m. on July 10<sup>th</sup> at Westlake UMC.
