Greater Austin Emmaus 4th Day Group Board of Directors Meeting Parker Lane UMC, Austin Thursday, December 3, 2015

The regular meeting of the GAE4DG Board was held on December 3rd at Parker Lane UMC commencing at 6:15 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Harold Sundbeck who gave the opening prayer. Present were: Harold Sundbeck, Assistant Lay Director; Mel Chambers, Rio Texas Board Representative and Immediate Past Lay Director; LeeLeen Sundbeck, Gathering Support; Carl Fisher, Walk Support; Sam Johnson, Treasurer; Jim Burgess, Member Support, and Rev. Sylvester Chase, Spiritual Director.

Assistant Lay Director's Opening Remarks: Harold Sundbeck welcomed everyone.

Minutes: The Board approved the November minutes by email and they were submitted to Kellye Noret for publication in the *WalkTalk*.

Treasurer's Report: Sam Johnson presented the treasurer's report. The ending balance as of December 3, 2015 was \$4,421.10, with an unencumbered balance of \$1,474.85 after outstanding liabilities of \$2,946.26. The Scholarship balance is \$2,402.71. Walk #1803 made \$543.55 since the walk had 35 pilgrims. Harold Sundbeck made the motion to approve, Mel Chambers seconded and it was approved unanimously.

Sam also reported we now have the capability to accept credit card payments by use of Square. He presented the new Walk Application forms and reported they should be available on line very soon.

Rio Texas Board Representative's Report: Mel Chambers reported he will make sure the conference gets the new Application Fees schedule and also that the current fee will increase 1/1/2016 from \$215 to \$240 for 2016 Walks. Mel is still looking for LD candidates.

Walk Support: Carl Fisher reported he will be leaving in January to move to St. Paul. Tonight there will be Agape lists to be passed around since the only new Walk will be Walk #1821 in February. By the time he leaves there will be enough worship books for all the upcoming walks in 2016.

Old Business: Harold Sundbeck reported that Chris and Myles McKemie and Tom and Anne Rioux met with Pastor Ella Luna and David Ancira of Emmanuel UMC welcoming them into our conference. They discussed ways that the GAE4DG could help in awakening Emmaus in their church. They are very interested in getting involved and would like to have an Emmaus Sunday at Emmanuel UMC on January 10, 2016. A Traditional Spanish Worship will be at 9:00 and a Blended English Worship Service at 11:00. It would be wonderful to have members of the community and the Board attend to show support and encouragement. Harold indicated he would attend.

Walk Reports: Walk #1821 – Harold reported they had the first team meeting and the next will be on December 12, 2015.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:00 p.m. by Harold Sundbeck. Mel Chambers gave the closing prayer.
