# 50th Anniversary of the 1966 Starr County farm worker march to Austin

Join Bishop Martinez
for the 50th Anniversary Celebration to Commemorate
1966 Farm Worker March to Austin
Sunday, September 11, 2016
Austin, Texas

Let us continue the struggle of the Starr County farm workers, who led a strike in the melon fields in the summer of 1966, and then marched 400 miles, beginning on July 4, from the Valley to Austin, and arriving at the Capitol on Labor Day, 1966. When they arrived, 10,000 people joined the last 4 miles of the march from St. Edward's University to the Capitol.

Their struggle for economic justice was the beginning of the United Farm Workers union in Texas and sparked the Chicano movement. They laid the foundation in the fight for justice that continues today in the struggle for a living wage.

Join us to celebrate the farm workers' historic struggle at a commemoration and march on Sunday, September 11th and to support their continuing struggle for justice in the fields.

### Greater Austin Emmaus Community Board of Directors Meeting Minutes Thursday, August 4, 2016

The following directors were present: Jeanne Randall, Secretary; Nickie Carstarphen, Treasurer; Mel Chambers, Upper Room Representative; Rob Turk, Member Services Coordinator; Silvia Villarreal-Rocco, Gathering Support Coordinator; Rev. Sylvester Chase, Spiritual Director. It was determined that six (6) directors were present, which did constitute a quorum.

Rev Chase opened the meeting with prayer before the meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Mel Chambers, who presided over the meeting. Mel shared that we are now officially a Community directly under the Upper Room. RTECC will still be available, for a short period of time, to answer questions as we transition to a self-standing Community. We need to work with the District to support and recruit Pastors. RTECC made the initial disbursement of funds on July 31. GAEC received two checks totaling \$5362.44. This was the amount received from merger of GAEC4DG and ABC4DG.

**Minutes:** The Board of Directors Meeting Minutes were sent by email for the previous meeting held on July 7, 2016. After corrections were made, the minutes were approved and adopted as emailed.

**Treasurers Report:** Nickie reported that the new bank account is with Frost Bank. She has transferred the funds and will close the Wells Fargo account when all checks have cleared. As of July bank statement, we have \$9225.40. Scholarship money needs to be transferred out of the General Fund into the Scholarship account so that there can be an accurate accounting and the records be reconciled. Nick ie requested that there be a written protocol for making entries into the bookkeeping system. If a new Treasurer doesn't understand the system, mistakes will be made. With new people coming on board it is critical that they "know where" certain entries should be entered. The Scholarship application is online. The standard Scholarship is 1/3 the Pilgrim fee. However, if a request for additional funds is made, it is brought to the Board of Directors for a vote of approval. A motion was made and seconded that the Treasurer's Report be accepted as presented. The motion passed.

**Rio Texas Board Rep Report:** Mel will mail the \$1,000.00 deposit check for each of the Walks that are scheduled at Cathedral Oaks. Walk #141, March 30 – April 2, and Walk #142, – October 12 – 15. Team Selection is scheduled for August 25, 7:00 pm at Wesley UMC.

**Gathering Support:** Silvia reported that no church has expressed willingness to host the Gathering for November. Cedar Creek UMC will host the December Gathering. Various churches do not have enough support to host a monthly gathering.

Walk Support Report: Carl was not present, but his report indicated everything from the cancelled Walk will be transferred to Walk #141.

**Member Support Report:** Rob stated that no one has contacted him to take over the position of Music Coordinator.

Walk #141 Lay Director Report: Rob reported that there have been questions about the fees charged for the caretaker of a disabled pilgrim. Fees for the caregivers of pilgrims is the same as the Servant Team.

**Spiritual Director Report:** Rev. Sylvester Chase said we need to look at the Emmaus spirit. We need to need to find out why Clergy and Laity are not actively supporting the movement. Rev Chase suggested that we all fast...skip lunch and pray about the movement.

General Discussion: Team members are concerned about GAEC not reaching out to other denominations. We need to brainstorm recruiting other denominations. Having only one Men's Walk and one Women's Walk a year may spark more interest. If people have to wait longer to attend, they might be more likely to sign up earlier. Craig will contact Scott Elliff from the Corpus Christi Emmaus Community and report back to the Board with regard to any ideas for facilitating a more extended meeting of the Board and/or the Community to pray together and discuss ideas of how to re-ignite interest in and the growth of the Emmaus movement.

**Old Business:** The following old business was discussed, with any items discussed or actions taken as noted below.

RTECC: Mel spoke at the beginning of the meeting about disbursement of funds and the limited support available after the dissolution of RTECC.

**Bylaws** – The Bylaws were discussed. The consensus was that we should wait until next month, when more of the Board can be in attendance, to vote to approve the Bylaws. Nicki made the motion that each position on the Board have a three-year rotation. Rob seconded the motion. Discussion followed. With the rotation, the  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  person in the position will be in Progressive Servanthood as well as be aware of the details of the office and the responsibilities and the direction of the Board. The motion passed. Board approved the information and staggering of terms as set forth in the attached Table of Officers and Directors:

- May 2018 Harold Sundbeck, Mel Chambers, Rev. Sylvester E. Chase, Jr.
- May 2019 LeeLeen Sundbeck, Jeanne Randall, Nickie Carstarphen

Craig was reimbursed the money he spent making copies of the Bylaws and the Table of Officers and Directors for the meeting.

The ABC Trailer must have new tags by the end of the month.

**New Business:** No new business discussed as we ran out of time. It was recommended that we meet at 5:30 next month to discuss and approve the Bylaws so that the 501c3 process can be completed.
