HAPPY NEW YEAR!



Just Returned From Your Walk to Emmaus? Now What?



Just like many of you, as soon as you get off cloud nine from your Walk and your 4th Days have started, you ask yourself, "What do I do now?" Here are a few opportunities that will help enhance your Walk and the journey you are now on.

- \Rightarrow **Reunion Groups:** Join a Reunion Group, or start one with other pilgrims from your Walk. Once you meet there are opportunities to give back to the Emmaus community. Remember all that pillow agape left on your bed? Your group can make something for an upcoming Walk. It doesn't have to be expensive keep it simple with a scripture on an index card would be great.
- ⇒ **Gatherings:** Go to Gatherings, especially when it's held at your church. This is a way to connect to many others, hear individual's 4th Day talks and their journey. Perhaps your Reunion Group can carpool. Don't forget the Potluck before the Gathering. We've changed things recently and we ask all who are coming to the Gatherings to bring a food item of any kind to share, prior to singing and the service.
- ⇒ Walk to Emmaus Outside Team: This gives you a first-hand look at the behind the scenes of what all has to be done to ensure the Walk goes smoothly. The team is there from Thursday afternoon until Sunday evening. The outside team is responsible for the snack times in the conference room, letters, making sure pillow agape gets put on beds, and many other duties.
- \Rightarrow Walk to Emmaus Inside Team: It is recommended you serve on an outside team prior to applying to be part of an inside team. You can find an application on the Emmaus website for you to complete. Once the team has been selected, it meets at least 6 months prior to the Walk to practice and review talks and responsibilities for each team member.
- \Rightarrow **Candlelight Service:** Just as you recall the feelings you felt when you walked in and saw all the Emmaus community there to support you, you can now come give those pilgrims that same overwhelming feeling. Usually groups will carpool together and stop along the way to share a meal on the way.
- ⇒ Serve on the Emmaus Board: Talk to a Board member if you have a desire to join the Board. There are always opportunities to serve!
- \Rightarrow **Sponsorship:** Just like your sponsor talked to you about the Walk, provided transportation to and from the retreat center for you, participated in the Prayer Vigil, and attended Candlelight and Closing, now you can give someone the same experience you felt on *your* Walk.

These are just a few ways to stay connected to the Emmaus community!

There is only ONE Men's Walk and ONE Women's Walk in 2017

The Greater Austin Emmaus Community will sponsor only two walks in 2017, one for men and one for women. If sponsors do not get their pilgrims signed up for Men's Walk #141, March 30 – April 2, or Women's Walk #142, October 12 - 15, and if those Walks do not make, it will be 2018 before they have the opportunity to do so again. The Upper Room guidelines stipulate that a Walk must have 20 pilgrims signed up in order for the Walk to occur.

In the past, people have been able to casually let a Walk deadline slide past on the calendar because another Walk would occur within months. This is no longer the case. The wait for men who signed up for Walk #1847 (which was replaced by Walk #141) to 2018 would be over 24 months. PLEASE prayerfully consider your Walk To Emmaus experience, and the men and women in your life who might benefit from this experience, and discuss with potential pilgrims what the Walk To Emmaus meant to you in your life, and then work to share that experience with others.

The cost of these Walks is \$198.00, but scholarship funds are available. Check with your local church point-of-contact, your pastor, or with the Lay Director for the Walk for scholarship assistance.
