

Global Walks

Earlier this year, the **Emmaus Community of Ghana** responded to the need to grow the ministry beyond the country's capital city.

On March 30th, 2017, the community sent a group of 23 men to the city of Ofoase Kokoben. One month later, 34 women representing a host of ministries from various denominations attended their retreat in the village of Santasi. The two events, the first to be held in the Ashanti Region of the country, were Ghana Emmaus' response to a question that arose during their 20th anniversary celebration. The challenge was to find ways to grow the ministry and to allow Ghanaians living outside of the capital city of Accra to experience God's grace in new ways. We rejoice with and give thanks for the community's vision and determination. (See photos on the next page.)

The new Emmaus Community of Bolivia will hold its first walks from July 5th to 8th and July 10th to 13th. Bolivia is one of 8 countries launching a new community – all within five years – as part of the "8 in 5" initiative. Kenya and Bolivia hold their first walks this year, while leadership teams in Bulgaria, Peru, Poland, Uganda, Democratic Republic of Congo, and Chile are in various stages of formation.

Greater Austin Emmaus Community Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes St. Mark UMC, June 1, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by LeeLeen Sundbeck, who opened the meeting with prayer and presided over the meeting.

The following directors were present: LeeLeen Sundbeck, Lay Director; Rob Turk, Assistant Lay Director and Member Services Coordinator; Jeanne Randall, Secretary; Mel Chambers, Upper Room Representative; Carl Fisher, Walk Support Coordinator (*by phone*); Sylvester Chase, Spiritual Director; Harold Sundbeck, Immediate Past Lay Director. Additionally, Chris McKemie was present.

QUORUM: It was determined that 8 directors were present, which did constitute a quorum.

MINUTES: The Board of Directors Meeting Minutes were reviewed and corrections made. Mel Chambers made the motion that the minutes be accepted as corrected. Rob Turk seconded the motion, and the motion passed. The minutes were accepted as corrected.

The following items were discussed:

UPPER ROOM REPORT – Mel will communicate with Ed to get the website Board Roster undated so that emails are going to the new Board Members. Jeanne indicated that there were Team Manuals, Emmaus brochures, and other miscellaneous materials on the "ABC" trailer that should be reviewed for publication dates and inventoried.

WALK SUPPORT – Harold and Carl will work together until someone can take over for Carl.

MEMBER SUPPORT – One new person signed up (for the emails?). Jeanne recommended that new pilgrims be automatically added to the email list. They can always opt out if they choose. More needs to be said about the email during the Walk, so the pilgrims understand that the email network is how we stay in touch between Gatherings, etc.

SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR – We are missing the spiritual connection between the church pastor and the Community. If the pastor isn't on board with/for the Emmaus movement, the local congregation will lose it's momentum. We must brainstorm ideas for personal contact with the various pastors. We need a contact in each church. We need to talk to the Bishop. He "drives the ship".

OLD BUSINESS – Merging of the two trailers. A discussion of whether to sell or donate the extra trailer to the Kairos Outside Ministry. Rob made the motion to donate the trailer, Mel seconded the motion, and the motion passed. Jeanne was given permission to donate any "extras and duplicate supplies" to facilitate the merging of the trailers. Chris will arrange to get the kneeler repaired when the trailer returns to her property.

NEW BUSINESS – None

WALK #142 REPORT – Kristin indicated that she has lost one team member and may possibly lose another one. A recommendation was made to contact Dot Files as a replacement.

ADJOURNMENT: At 6:05 p.m., a motion was made that the meeting be adjourned. The meeting adjourned at 6:06 p.m.
