The Board has recognized the challenges for our community and we have discussed alternatives. One of our new members came to us from Houston and they had experienced similar issues. If you have spent any time in Houston and tried to drive across that town, you know the time commitment that will take. So what did the Houston Emmaus community do? They now have Gatherings every other month and meet on a Saturday evening with a potluck dinner. This has allowed the members of the community to plan ahead, gives them the luxury of time to drive to the Gathering without feeling rushed, and time to prepare something to share at the potluck. They also schedule events and training classes prior to the potluck. The result has been a larger attendance at the Gatherings, greater fellowship, and full walks.

We will be advertising these changes at our April Gathering on Thursday April 5th at First Pflugerville UMC. We will also have the team commissioning for Walk #144 at that Gathering.

So, beginning with the May Gathering at Northwest Hills UMC, we will meet on Saturday May 5th at 5:00 PM. We will also utilize the time to have the Welcome Back for Walk #144. That way the community will be able to extend a large welcome to the pilgrims into the Greater Austin Emmaus Community.

This brings me to a request. We need pilgrims for Men's Walk #144. So, I'm asking each of you and also each of your reunion groups to be in prayer for the pilgrims to answer His call to attend the Walk and experience the best Walk ever.



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Board of Directors Meeting Minutes March 1, 2018, Manor UMC

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m., by LD Leeleen Sundbeck, who opened and presided over the meeting. The following directors were present: LeeLeen Sundbeck, Lay Director; Rob Turk, Assistant Lay Director; Jeanne Randall, Secretary; Patti Bizzell, Treasurer; Mel Chambers, Upper Room Rep.; Tisha Christopher, Member Services Coor.; Steven Scott, Gathering Support Coor.; Harold Sundbeck, Walk Support Coor. and Past Lay Director; Rev. Sylvester Chase, Spiritual Director; Coe Grace, Lay Director Men's Walk #144 (non-voting); Chris McKemie, Lay Director Women's Walk #143 (non-voting). QUOREM: It was determined that 9 Directors were present, which did constitute a quorum. Our guests were Myles McKemie, Tisha Christopher, Kim Newman and Bradley Bizzell.

<u>MINUTES:</u> The Board of Directors Meeting Minutes were sent by email for the previous meeting held on February 1, 2018. The minutes were approved by email and the emails are filed with the Minutes.

<u>TREASURER'S REPORT</u> – Patti moved that the Treasurer's report be accepted as presented by email. Rob seconded the motion and the motion passed. A copy of the report is filed with the minutes; Patti confirmed that the IRS 990N report has been filed and that the Directors and Officers Liability Insurance was paid; There is no credit card at this time. Additional information has been sent to the company and Patti is waiting for a response.

<u>UPPER ROOM REPORT</u> –The Covenant with the Upper Room was signed at the March meeting. Mel reported that CYJ has not sent the contract for Walk #144, so the check has not been sent because we don't have the contract. Also, the 2019 dates have not been confirmed by CYJ. He will be ordering Director (Coordinator?) manuals for each Board member. The manuals will be set up so that they can be passed on to the next person taking the Board position. He will also be ordering Team Manuals.

GATHERING SUPPORT – Steven Scott is willing to become the new Gathering Support Director. Rob moved that Steven be appointed to the position; it was seconded by Kristin and passed. After much discussion, Steve made the motion that the Gatherings be moved to Saturdays of odd-numbered months, with two churches sharing the responsibility for the preparation, hosting, and cleanup afterwards. Steve will work closely with the churches currently scheduled to host. Leeleen seconded the motion and it passed. This will begin with the May "Welcome Back" Gathering following Walk #144.

<u>WALK SUPPORT</u> – The Agape and Prayer Vigil sign-ups are active on the GAEC website; Jeanne also brought them to the Gathering. The trailer is scheduled to be worked on, straightened, and inventoried on March 4th.

<u>MEMBER SUPPORT</u> – Kristin has asked Tisha to use her expertise to make the communication system better for the Community.

<u>ASSISTANT LAY DIRECTOR REPORT</u> – Rob emailed suggestions for the opening Board positions based on the current Bylaws. He is recommending Kristin Hampsten for ALD, Steven Scott for Gathering Support, and Tish Christopher for the position of Member Support Coordinator.

SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR – Rev. Chase asked if there were Guidelines for the 4th Talk. We confirmed that there were guidelines, but that Talk Guidelines are just suggestions to follow and cannot be enforced.

<u>OLD BUSINESS</u> – A committee will be formed to establish a data management process (DMP) that meets the needs of the GAEC that preserves the confidentiality and privacy of members, pilgrims, sponsors, vendors, etc. Leeleen suggested hiring an outside person to rebuild the database. Tisha has a contact for the rebuilding of the database. It was recommended that Mel be the person to meet with the person as he is most familiar with the database and the information that it must contain; Everyone's "job descriptions" have been put into Dropbox for review. These need to go into a policies and procedures manual, so that when new people join the Board they are aware of the duties, time lines of commitments etc.; Because of traffic and time constraints, we are going to explore the idea of having the Board meetings on the Sunday before the Gatherings. The only concern would be the issue that Board Meetings must be open to the GAEC Community.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u> – Rob moved and Kristin seconded the motion to approve the Team Selection list for Walk #143, and the motion passed; Leeleen is going to do a site visit at the Twin Lakes Retreat facility for the possible move for future Walks.

<u>WALK #143 REPORT</u> – Chris reported that everything is going smoothly towards Walk #143. Rev Tom Deviney has the Spiritual Team in place, LaMonica Lewis is leading the Music Team, and Chris can begin recruiting the rest of her team.

<u>WALK #144 REPORT</u> – Coe has six pilgrims. Team Meetings are progressing and the Team Consecration will be at the April 5th Gathering.

ANNOUNCEMENTS – Reminder of the trailer work day at Chris & Myles' home on March 4th.

ADJOURNMENT: At 7:00 p.m. a motion was made that the meeting be adjourned, and it adjourned at 7:02 p.m.
