Dear Community,

Now that Men's Walk #144 is over, it's time to begin planning ahead for Women's Walk #143, Nov. 15-18. The team has already been preparing and having team meetings. Now is the time for US to be in preparation. Here are some ways we can do this:

- \Rightarrow Pray for the team.
- ⇒ Pray for prospective pilgrims, especially for those who you think might be ready to further their spiritual journey by attending a Walk to Emmaus.
- \Rightarrow Offer to be a sponsor.
- ⇒ Begin thinking about agape you or your reunion group can provide. Remember, no individual names can go on the agape, only the name of the reunion group and/or the church.
- ⇒ Bring awareness of this Walk to your church. If your church has an Emmaus yahoo group, or a list of folks who have been on a Walk, encourage them also to be in prayer, and for who they might want to approach and offer to be their sponsor.
- ⇒ Ask your pastor to say a brief word from the pulpit, and refer them to someone who can give them more information about it.
- ⇒ Have available between services a table or an area with Walk to Emmaus information, and someone there to explain it and answer questions.

These are just a few of the things we can do to promote this Walk!

Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes May 3, 2018, Northwest Hills UMC

The meeting was called to order at 6:07 p.m., by ALD Rob Turk, who opened with prayer and presided over the meeting. The following directors were present: Rob Turk, Assistant Lay Director; Jeanne Randall, Secretary; Patti Bizzell, Treasurer; Mel Chambers, Upper Room Rep.; Kristin Hampsten, Member Services Coor.; Steven Scott, Gathering Support Coor.; Harold Sundbeck, Walk Support Coor. and Immediate Past Lay Director; Chris McKemie, Lay Director, Walk #143 (non-voting); Brenda Hightower, Lay Director, Walk #146 (non-voting). **QUORUM:** It was determined that 7 Directors were present, which did constitute a quorum. Our guests were Myles McKemie and Brenda Hightower, LD for Women's Walk #146.

<u>MINUTES:</u> The Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes were sent by email for the previous meeting held on April 4, 2018. The minutes were approved by email and the emails are filed with the Minutes.

<u>TREASURER'S REPORT</u> – Patti made a motion that the approvals for Pilgrim Scholarships that had been requested, approved by email, but not formally voted on, be approved. The motion was seconded by Rob and the motion passed.

Patti made a motion that the line item for Scholarships be transferred from General Funds to Scholarships. Steven Scott seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Patti printed out the Financial Report by Walk to reflect the deposits paid in 2017 to CYJ, and Credit Card fees of \$43. She reported that approximately \$400 of in-kind donations are not included on the financial statements. Patti reported that the Aplos Accounting Software will be increasing from \$270 to \$300 next year.

<u>UPPER ROOM REPORT</u> – There is the possibility of changes to the 3-day schedule from Upper Room. Mel will keep us informed. Walk #144 Closeout report is complete.

<u>GATHERING SUPPORT</u> – Dates for the upcoming Gatherings have been confirmed. Steven has created a flyer for the Gatherings. He is continuing to work on getting Reunion Group and P.O.C. information updated. He is hoping that with the new schedule we will start attracting 200-250 people at each Gathering. The proposed topic for "training" at the July meeting is Sponsorship. It was suggested to contact Anne Rioux to present the training. The tentative plan for the September Gathering is to have an Agape Making Party.

<u>WALK SUPPORT</u> – The trailer went to Jeanne after the Walk for inventory and organizing. She has a preliminary sign-up sheet printed for tonight's Gathering, but will continue to tweak it as she finishes the inventory. The online sign-ups will "go hot" after she inputs the information from tonight. Her goal is to have only what we need for a Walk on the trailer...currently there are enough glue sticks, construction paper, and other perishable supplies for at least the next 5-6 Walks. She reported that it is a "work in progress" that will probably take at least one more Walk to pare down the supplies. Jeanne would like to add "green agape" to the sign-up so that people can donate cash towards the Walk. This would need to be researched to find a way to make a donation that can be done online (Paypal, Google Pay, etc).

<u>MEMBER SUPPORT</u> – Kristen is still researching the best method for communicating with the GAEC community. She is looking for a volunteer that can take the current *WalkTalk* and convert it from Publisher to HTML so that it can be sent out in a less complicated way.

ASSISTANT LAY DIRECTOR REPORT – We are still searching for a new Music Coordinator for the Community.

OLD BUSINESS -

A committee will be formed to establish a data management process (DMP) that meets the needs of the GAEC that preserves the confidentiality and privacy of members, pilgrims, sponsors, vendors, etc.

A policies and procedures manual needs to be created so that when new people join the Board they are aware of the duties, timelines of commitments, etc.

A new date and time for Board meetings (between the Gatherings) needs to be established.

The possible move from CYJ to Twin Lakes was discussed. It was determined that we would have Walk #143 at CYJ to honor the contract and give us time to do the necessary research and contract negotiations with Twin Lakes YMCA. There are too many issues that have to be discussed and worked through before we can consider making the change of location. Patti moved that Mel create a cost analysis spreadsheet so we make a more accurate comparison of the two facilities. She also moved that the buildings at Twin Lakes be studied to ensure adequate needs for a Walk are met. Rob seconded the motions and they passed.

<u>WALK #143 REPORT</u> – Chris reported that everything is going smoothly towards Walk #143. Her team is in place. The first team meeting is June 2nd and the Board has been invited to attend the Worship service, sign the Covenant, and be a visible presence to the team. She requested that the First Aid Kit be brought to the Team Meeting (the Board Rep. is responsible for updating supplies).

WALK #144 REPORT – The financial Closeout report has been completed and turned in.

ADJOURNMENT: At 7:40 p.m., a motion was made that the meeting be adjourned. The meeting adjourned at 7:41 p.m. *Minutes taken and respectfully submitted by Jeanne Randall.*

Do you remember the wonderful feeling you had on your Emmaus weekend? How beautiful it felt to have truly spent that precious time experiencing God's love like **never** before? Would you like to share that experience with others? That is what sponsorship is all about!!

We will have the Joys of Sponsoring a Pilgrim training event at our next Gathering on July 14th at 4pm. The Gathering is at Cedar Creek UMC located at 5630 FM 535, Cedar Creek, Texas, 78612, 512-303-1393. We will have and will discuss the sponsoring forms to fill out, explain the sponsor duties, have stories from past sponsors, and answer questions that everyone may have. It should be a fun time for all. To give you a taste of what we will hear, I asked my wife, Paula Scott, to discuss her recent sponsoring of a pilgrim on Men's Walk #144. From Paula:

Being new to the Greater Austin Emmaus Community (GAEC), coming from Houston and the Houston West Emmaus Community, I recently had the opportunity to sponsor a pilgrim here in Austin. My pilgrim was a member of our Sunday School class. Steven and I talked to him last year about attending the Emmaus Men's Walk. We shared with him things that we had experienced on Walks over the years that we have been involved in. We discussed how we and others had felt God's love and how we had all changed. We discussed that the main purpose was to build up leaders in the individual churches of the Emmaus community. We were cautious not to be overly excited or too exuberant, making it out to be more than it might be for him. We told him everyone gets something out of it based on where they are in their walk with the Lord. He prayed about going on the Emmaus weekend but the time was a conflict with his schedule. He told us to let him know in 2018 so he could schedule the Emmaus Walk. We told him when the weekend was this year and he agreed to go on Men's Walk #144.

I picked him up on Thursday afternoon for the drive to Camp Young Judaea (CYJ). We had a very enjoyable ride, using the opportunity to get to know each other better by sharing our life stories and experiences. He was very excited about the weekend. I dropped him off at CYJ in the loving hands of the team, his brothers in Christ. I attended the Sponsors Hour where his candle was lit for the first time, and I prayed over his lanyard.

I returned for Candlelight, anxiously hoping that I could "read" his face to see what kind of experience he was having. As he passed by me in the procession, I saw the smile, with tears in his eyes. His life had been touched!

Closing, as always, was a true blessing. The pilgrims shared how their lives had been touched by the time they spent with God and their brothers in Christ. Many said their lives have been changed. My pilgrim had the same response. Praise the Lord! When I finally got to be with him, he confessed that he had come to the Emmaus weekend with expectations, "knowing what it was going to be about." But, he said, "my expectations were blown out of the water, WOW!!!" God truly showed up, as he always does!!

Sponsoring a pilgrim is a blessing and a privilege. Pray about it and ask God to lead you to those you can share this beautiful experience with.
