Greetings Emmaus Community!

As we move into 2019, we are praying as a Board for direction on how to move the community forward. Inspired by Arnie's update below, and his reference to the 1 John verse, this article is focused on stepping out in perfect love and service opportunities in this community.

God is at work preparing hearts and minds already for the Greater Austin Emmaus Men's Walk #145, led by Lay Director Arnie Waden and Spiritual Director Ray Kiser, April 11 – 14. Here's Arnie's latest update to share with the community:

"Friends, another challenge has emerged in the form of one of the ALD's having to drop out. At first, this was very scary and disheartening to me. But then I was reminded that 1 John 4:18 tells us that perfect love casts out all fear. And since I am confident in the love of Christ, there is nothing to fear. I am also confident that God is calling someone who has not previously stepped out in faith, and starting on the pathway to becoming a lay director. I don't know who it is, but God knows, and I encourage all to search their heart and decide if it is them. God is doing miraculous things in the life of His church and in the lives of those who are committed to being His servants on Walk #145. I hear weekly of more and more pilgrims expressing interest in attending this Walk, and it looks like this will indeed be the best Walk ever. Don't get left behind. Get out there and recruit a pilgrim, get on the servant team, commit to pray daily for the Walk, provide some agape, and search your heart and discover if it is you that God is calling to join the team of Walk #145. In other news, the Board is looking for ways to improve public communications, and we need you! We already have some wonderful volunteers like Kellye Noret, who writes this wonderful newsletter faithfully and posts events to Facebook; Ed Turner, who sends messages to the community and maintains our website; Diane Merwarth, who verifies the content is up to date on our website; and Tisha Christopher, Member Services Board Member, using her talents with media relations to help drive change in our public communications. We need more help though to help research and experiment with email programs, learn the new Upper Room Community Management Database, computer services to help with the database for upcoming Walks, and more. If God is leading you to serve in any capacity for GAEC, large or small, please let us know!

At the last Board meeting, we voted on some minor revisions to the Bylaws, and we will post them once they are signed. The changes were minor, but the intent was to remove restrictive language, such as which day to hold the Gatherings. Another noteworthy change is that the Board terms were changed to align to the fiscal calendar year (January – December instead of May – June). Since this year is special, our Annual Meeting which should have been held in December to elect new Board members will be held at the May Gathering. Moving forward, the Annual Meeting will be held in December. This year, in March, we will ask the community to nominate Board members, and then at the May Gathering Annual Meeting vote the new officers to the Board. If you have a servant's heart and a passion for the Emmaus movement, please consider joining us on the Board.

Thank you all for all you do by supporting this community, and please pray for God to raise up leaders and servants, including a lay director for Women's Walk #146 this Fall.

From the Lay Director of Women's Walk #143

Dear Blessed GAEC,

With our Lord guiding us and preparing us, the GAEC sponsored Women's Walk #143 on November 15 - 18, 2018 sent forth into our world 36 disciples for our Lord. All praise and glory to our God!

I do not know where each pilgrim was on her personal spiritual journey, but I do know that a weekend immersed in God's love and God's grace was very powerful. Over the four days, their minds were filled with knowledge given to them through scripture, so they would see our Lord more clearly, their hearts were filled with His love so that they would love Him more dearly, and their souls were filled with His grace so that they would follow Him more nearly. For all of their Fourth Days!

When the pilgrims arrived on Thursday evening, all were excited to finally be here for the Walk. Some were more excited than others, some were a little apprehensive about what they were getting themselves into, and all were anticipating what would be happening. Do you remember how we were told many, many times not to anticipate!?!? You just have to smile when you are asked, "Really, how long is 2 beads on the God watch? Is it 5, 10, 15 minutes?" And your answer is, "Please try not to anticipate and just listen for the bell." This had me remembering my first night on my pilgrim Walk. I must have woken up at least 3 times worried that I had missed the bell and had overslept. Then I would see my roommate still snuggled in bed, and I thought everything was okay until I thought, "Oh, no, we both have overslept!" That first night sleep was not very restful.

Some pilgrims anticipating their needs for the weekend brought colorful markers and notebooks, but Friday morning they learned all their needs would be taken care of and they just needed to surrender themselves to the weekend. Amazing talks were given by lay and clergy, followed by table discussions, the joy of preparing their skits, and the joy and fun of presenting their skits. Feelings, thoughts, and hearts were shared, tears were shed, and voices were raised in singing and laughter. It was truly a blessing to witness the Holy Sprit present and at work on this Walk.



Kairos Prison Ministry



Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes January 10, 2019 Bethany UMC

The meeting was called to order at 3:09 p.m. by Kristin Hampsten. LeeLeen Sundbeck opened the meeting with a prayer. Kristin Hampsten presided over the meeting. Attending were: Lay Director, Kristin Hampsten; Assistant Lay Director and Immediate Past Lay Director, LeeLeen Sundbeck; Secretary, Harold Sundbeck; Treasurer, Patti Bizzell; Upper Room Representative, Mel Chambers; Gathering Support Coordinator, Steven Scott; and Walk Support Coordinator, Jeanne Randall. Bradley Bizzell was also present.

QUORUM – Seven Board members were present.

<u>MINUTES</u> – The Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes were sent by email for the previous meeting held on December 6, 2018. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved by email.

REPORTS – The following officers, directors, or other persons presented reports to the Board of Directors, with any items discussed or actions taken as noted below. The following items were discussed:

TREASURER'S REPORT – Patti Bizzell had sent out the financial report by email. The Frost Bank balance reconciles with the Aplos balance of \$22,501.63. Patti made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report and Steven Scott seconded the motion. All approved. Patti reported she spent \$185 for a new easel and other supplies for the conference room. Patti also reported she had received an acknowledgement from the Upper Room for our \$500.00 contribution to The Gift, a fund utilized to help spread the Walk to Emmaus experience to other countries. Patti suggested we need to have a financial review performed and asked the Board to suggest names of those that could do this. Patti presented the 2019 budget, and after some discussion, made a motion to have it accepted. Kristin Hampsten seconded. All approved.

Patti reported that we have received \$325.00 in Memorial Contributions for Rob Turk, and another \$490.00 toward scholarships in Rob's honor. Patti suggested talking to Yolanda to see if she would be OK with moving the Memorial Contributions into Scholarships. Kristin will contact her.

<u>UPPER ROOM REPORT</u> – Mel Chambers reported we need to sign the Upper Room Covenant during our meeting. He will also check into cones for use at CYJ to mark driving areas.

<u>WALK SUPPORT</u> – Eben Files has picked up the trailer and will bring it to the Walk.

<u>GATHERING SUPPORT</u> – Steven Scott reported upcoming Gathering is set for January 12th starting at 5:00 pm, potluck at 6:00 pm and service at 7:00 pm. Sponsorship training will be at 5:00 pm. Terri Sloan and Mike Carmagnola are looking at helping with music for the Gathering. Steven will meet with the Board of Eagles Wings Emmaus Community to discuss the possibility of sharing ideas for a combined Gathering.

<u>MEMBER SUPPORT</u> – No report, however, there was some discussion as to using Constant Contact instead of the Yahoo Group for sending communications to the community.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u> – Next Board meeting will be February 7th at Kristin's house at 6:30 pm. The Annual meeting will be held in March this year and then again in December. Kristin made a motion to have the Board terms coincide with the calendar year. Steven seconded. All approved.

<u>OLD BUSINESS</u> – Kristin made a motion to approve the revisions to the Bylaws. LeeLeen seconded. All approved.

Kristin closed with a prayer and the meeting adjourned at 4:45 p.m.
