Reunion Group Meditation: Seeking Sisters

After my pilgrim walk in 2000, I was unable to join or start a reunion group because I worked full time, and all of my nights and weekends were devoted to keeping house and/or socializing. Once I retired in 2005, the door flew wide open to joining a group. For several years there were between 4 to 6 of us meeting like clockwork every Tuesday morning. Like so many people, there were serious life challenges that arose for each of us. I can personally attest to the power of laying down my burdens at reunion group and knowing that my friends would pray for me and keep my revelations completely confidential.

Then came the start of attrition, a slow but steady decline in membership. There were three of us who realized we could change our meeting place to one a lot closer to our homes, so we did that. For a brief time, we added three more members, then two left. Then one left. Then another left. Then we added one. Then we lost one. Now we are two.

While all of this was going on, I was privileged to be asked to join a Walk conference room team in 2018. During team formation our Board representative counseled us on the importance of being in a reunion group and passed out a document that describes what makes a good reunion group. She mentioned that she had been in the same group for decades!!! As I read through the document, I realized my group was not even meeting some basic guidelines, such as meeting faithfully every week. Not even close! At that time, we were three, and it seemed like we were always traveling or meeting service people at our homes or going to the doctor on our weekly reunion day. No fault of any one of us, it just kept being that way. So when we became two, my reunion buddy and I had a serious conversation about going forward. Should we disband? Should we look at another day or time? Could we recommit to our Tuesday morning?

We prayed about our choices. We decided not to give up! We made a plan to look ahead at each month and settle on our availability ahead of time on our calendars, and to do everything in our power NOT to schedule over our reunion time. We also changed our start time from 8:30 AM to 9:00 AM on Tuesday mornings. Meantime, we have recommitted to meeting and giving grace when life intervenes. We ARE the Seeking Sisters! We seek God's grace, we seek God's forgiveness, and we seek to set good priorities. We will pray for women in the Lakeway area who have been on a Walk and looking for a reunion group to consider joining us at 9:00 AM Tuesday mornings at the Starbuck's shop in the Randall's grocery store in Lakeway. 


Reminders for an Effective Reunion Group

- ⇒ Commit yourselves. When you feel like attending least, you need it most!
- ⇒ Prepare yourselves ahead of time.
- ⇒ Practice your disciplines in the intervening days.
- ⇒ Uphold one another. Discourage one another from making superficial responses, and be accountable to the members of your group for your Christian practice and growth.
- \Rightarrow Pray for one another.
- ⇒ Focus on the service card. Do not go over one hour.
- ⇒ Retreat with one another. Get together as a group once or twice a year for a quiet day of spiritual conversation, reflection on scripture, and prayer.
- ⇒ Plan your discipleship, set personal goals.
- \Rightarrow Act as a group. Plan to be in mission as a group.
- ⇒ Be spiritual friends. Help one another keep the fire burning inside.

THINGS TO AVOID

- ⇒ Be open to discussion of the members' expectations of the group and review every 6 months how well the group is meeting everyone's needs.
- ⇒ Be available to meet at a sick member's bedside if warranted.
- ⇒ Overseer mentality. No one takes over, dominates, reprimands.
- ⇒ Fear, lack of trust in group members.
- ⇒ Clique attitude: Caring only for each other.
- ⇒ Spiritual anemia or dullness arising from excess personal introspection rather than Christian action.

Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes March 7, 2019 Bethany UMC

The Board of Directors met March 7th at Bethany UMC. The following directors were present: LeeLeen Sundbeck, Acting Lay Director; Harold Sundbeck, Secretary; Patti Bizzell, Treasurer; Mel Chambers, Upper Room Representative (C); Steven Scott, Gathering Support Coordinator; Jeanne Randall, Walk Support Coordinator; and Rev. Sylvester E. Chase, Jr., Spiritual Director. C = Present by Call-in. **QUORUM:** Five Board members were present with one by call-in. Arnie Waden, Lay Director Men's Walk #145 (non-voting) and Jack Forman, Board Rep. for Men's Walk #145 (non-voting) were also present.

<u>MINUTES</u> – The Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes were sent by email for the previous meeting held on February 7, 2019. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved, with corrections, by email.

REPORTS –The following officers, directors, or other persons presented reports to the Board of Directors, with any items discussed or actions taken as noted below. The following items were discussed:

<u>TREASURER'S REPORT</u> – Patti had sent out the financial report by email. The Frost Bank balance reconciles with the Aplos balance of \$27,442.51. Patti made a motion to have the financial report approved. Steven seconded the motion. All approved.

Franchise Tax forms have been filed with the State of Texas and Form 990N has been filed with the IRS.

We have 10 pilgrims with funds deposited.

<u>UPPER ROOM REPORT</u> – Mel reported there have been several changes in staff at CYJ and they do not have us on their schedule for our upcoming Walk. They never sent us a contract so we will need to find another location. Discussion followed to contact Highland Lakes, YMCA, and Eagles Wings Retreat Center in Burnet. Steven made a call to the Eagles Wings Emmaus Lay Director since they had to cancel their Walk at Eagles Wings Retreat to see if we can take their Walk dates.

Dot Files has agreed to serve as the Lay Director for Women's Walk #146.

As follow-up, LeeLeen Sundbeck, Harold Sundbeck, Patti Bizzell, Steven Scott, and Paula Scott visited Eagles Wings Retreat Center in Burnet on Sunday, March 10^{th} and will sign contracts to use the facility May 2-5, 2019.

SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR – Pastor Chase brought up concerns about why we seem to have trouble getting pilgrims for our Walks. He posed the question as to how we can light a fire within our Emmaus community to generate enthusiasm once again. It's obvious it is not getting support from the top – Bishop, District Superintendents, or Pastors – so we need to grow it from the bottom up. Discussion followed to determine how we can use other means, i.e. social media, enthuse the POC's to send out info to their congregations, etc. LeeLeen suggested Board members attend other churches to demonstrate our support for Emmaus.

<u>GATHERING SUPPORT</u> – Steven brought info on Eagles Wings Retreat Center in Burnet and shared with the Board. He will contact Eagles Wings Retreat Center on Friday to get more information and let us know if we can move the Walk to May 2-5. We will make a decision this weekend since we have our Gathering and Team Commissioning on Saturday.

Steven is finalizing the musicians for the Gathering which also includes musicians from the Eagles Wings community. Patti Breaux will be giving the 4th Day talk. There will be an Agape making party prior to the Gathering. We will need greeters to help direct our guests. Harold will contact Joe Dale Morris to send out an email to those on his contact list to help with the Gathering.

<u>WALK #145 REPORT</u> – Arnie reported there are 10 pilgrims in the Registrar with several other potential pilgrims. Arnie made a request for a ½ scholarship for a pilgrim. Steven seconded and all approved.

Arnie will start contacting the pilgrims and sponsors concerning the potential date change for Walk #145. The next Team meeting is on March 9th at Bethany UMC.

NEW BUSINESS

LeeLeen will make an announcement about the open Board positions at the Gathering. Also, that due to potential changes in the date for the next Gathering we will table filling the positions until a later date. The job descriptions that Patti sent out were discussed and will be placed on the website so the community can see the duties for each position.

LeeLeen brought up discussion about articles for the *WalkTalk*. She will write the Lay Director article, and Steven and Harold will also submit articles.

No action at this time for the financial audit.

The Board signed the revised By-laws and they were imprinted with our seal.

Harold Sundbeck closed with prayer and the meeting adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
