GAEC Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes May 9, 2019 Northwest Hills UMC

The meeting was called to order at 6:42 p.m. by LeeLeen Sundbeck, who opened with a prayer and presided over the meeting. The following Directors were present: LeeLeen Sundbeck, Acting Lay Director; Harold Sundbeck, Secretary; Patti Bizzell, Treasurer; Mel Chambers, Upper Room Representative; Steven Scott, Gathering Support Coordinator; and Jeanne Randall, Walk Support Coordinator (C). C = Present by Call-in.

QUORUM: Five Board members were present. Jeanne Randall was present by phone call. Chris McKemie, co-Servant Team Coordinator for Walk #145, was also present.

<u>MINUTES</u>: The Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes were sent by email for the previous meeting held on April 4, 2019, and were approved, with corrections, by email.

REPORTS: The following officers, directors, or other persons presented reports to the Board of Directors, with any items discussed or actions taken as noted below:

<u>TREASURER'S REPORT</u> – Patti Bizzell had sent out the financial report by email. The Frost Bank balance reconciles with the Aplos balance of \$28,703.13. Patti made a motion to approve the report; Jeanne Randall seconded the motion. All approved.

Patti made a motion to approve a scholarship for a servant team member. Mel Chambers seconded the motion. All approved.

Prior to Walk #145, Patti sent out an email request for funds to purchase room divider screens and surge protectors. Approved by email.

Patti suggested looking into purchasing 2-way radios for future use at Eagle's Wings Retreat Center; Steven Scott will research this.

Patti brought up issues with the final billing from Eagle's Wings Retreat Center; however, Steven had a newer billing statement, and will speak with Katie at Eagle's Wings Retreat Center to reconcile the final billing invoice.

<u>UPPER ROOM REPORT</u> – Mel reported we have plenty of purple books and 4th day books. He will order more crosses for the lanyards. He also reported we are on the Upper Room list for integration into the database.

<u>WALK SUPPORT</u> – Jeanne reported she has the office supply box, table boxes, and St. Elsewhere box, but is missing the tissue box covers, table bibles, and crosses.

LeeLeen suggested updating our inventory list and posting it on the trailer when we meet to go through the trailer and re-organize for our next Walk. We will set a time to go through the trailer.

We will need to meet with the team for Women's Walk EW 142 to discuss what they will need from our trailer.

Patti suggested training the Conference Room team on how to pack up the Conference Room. Steven reported that the Houston community did extensive training and that we should investigate better preparing the teams by following the team guidelines that are in the manuals. The Board is planning on attending the training session for the first team meeting for Women's Walk EW 142 on May 18th.

<u>GATHERING SUPPORT</u> – Steven has sent out the announcement for the May 18th Gathering at Pflugerville UMC. The Gathering will begin at 4:00 p.m. with a Welcome Back for the pilgrims from Walk #145 in the Upper Room off the fellowship hall. The next Gathering will be a joint Gathering with the Eagle's Wings community on July 13th at Round Rock Presbyterian Church.

WALK #145 REPORT – Arnie will make his Walk report at the May 18th Gathering.

OLD BUSINESS – The financial review is on hold for now.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u> – LeeLeen reported that Mike Carmagnola will take over as Music Coordinator. LeeLeen suggested July 21st for Emmaus Sunday. Need to contact all the POC's to set up tables to promote the Walk to Emmaus.

Women's Walk EW 142, will have a Registrar from both communities with access to a single Dropbox to list pilgrims and the status of their payments. Funds will be held separately for each community.

Steven suggested leasing space at an RV storage facility between Bertram and Burnet to keep the trailer near the retreat center. The space is covered, which will help with maintaining the trailer. LeeLeen made a motion to lease space for the trailer. Patti seconded the motion. All approved.

LeeLeen brought up discussion about articles for the WalkTalk. She will write the LD article. Patti said she would submit an article.

Steven Scott closed with prayer and the meeting adjourned at 8:01 p.m.
