#### GAEC Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes June 6, 2019, Northwest Hills UMC

The meeting was called to order at 6:38 by LeeLeen Sundbeck, who opened with a prayer and presided over the meeting. The following Directors were present: LeeLeen Sundbeck, Acting Lay Director; Harold Sundbeck, Secretary; Patti Bizzell, Treasurer; Mel Chambers, Upper Room Support (C); Steven Scott, Gathering Support Coordinator; and Jeanne Randall, Walk Support Coordinator (C). C = Present by Call-in. Arnie Waden, Lay Director of Men's Walk #145 and Nelda Carpenter, Lay Director of Women's Walk EW 142 were also present. **QUORUM:** Four Board members were present with Mel Chambers and Jeanne Randall present by call-in.

MINUTES: The minutes of the previous meeting of May 9, 2019 were sent by email and were approved, with corrections, by email.

**REPORTS:** The following officers, directors, or other persons presented reports to the Board of Directors, with any items discussed or actions taken as noted below. The following items were discussed:

<u>TREASURER'S REPORT</u> – Patti had sent out the financial report by email. The Frost Bank balance reconciles with the Aplos balance of \$22,558.53. Patti made a motion to approve the report, Jeanne seconded the motion. All approved.

Patti reported issues with a credit card charge for Walk #145 that had been denied. Discussion followed that Patti will keep charge receipts until the end of the year for all credit card charges. Steven Scott made a motion to add a service fee of \$7.50 to cover the card company fees by the payer. Harold seconded. All approved.

Patti spent \$191.95 for fresh food for Walk #145 since no one signed up for food agape. She reported it was easier for her to do the shopping for the fresh food than wait until the day of the Walk.

Steven suggested placing a basket for scholarship donations at the Gatherings and making an announcement that we need donations.

<u>UPPER ROOM REPORT</u> – Prior to the BOD's meeting, Mel requested funds to purchase new team and Lay Director Manuals to be in compliance with the Upper Room. He reported that we have plenty of purple books and 4<sup>th</sup> day books. He also reported that we are still on the Upper Room list for integration into the database but no date as to when we will be added. No current status on Dropbox. Steven suggested using Google Drive for shared access for file storage.

<u>WALK SUPPORT</u> – Jeanne reported that she has the office supply box, batteries, table boxes, the St. Elsewhere supplies box and several boxes of votive candle holders at her house. She will contact the Eagles Wings Agape Coordinator to set up the sign-up lists.

Steven reported that he hasn't heard if there is an opening at the RV storage facility between Bertram and Burnet. When he gets information that a space is available, we will schedule a time to inventory the trailer.

<u>GATHERING SUPPORT</u> – Steven will prepare an announcement for the July 13<sup>th</sup> Gathering at Round Rock Presbyterian Church. July 21<sup>st</sup> will be Emmaus Sunday.

<u>WALK #145 REPORT</u> – Arnie delivered his report on Walk #145. It covered the Eagle's Wings Retreat facility and how wonderful it was for everyone. He especially liked how close all the buildings were, making it easy to move from the dining hall to the conference room and chapel. He had some suggestions for keeping the noise level down when using the west end of the dining hall for chapel.

WALK EW 142 REPORT – Nelda reported Walk EW 142 needs a Spiritual Director since the current SD had to step down due to health issues. They will also coordinate with Jeanne for use of trailer items so they can keep their special Walk items separate from ours. Nelda will suggest to the Eagles Wings Board to re-evaluate their fee structure for Walks to possibly match our current fee structure for scholarships for clergy.

<u>OLD BUSINESS</u> – Steven will speak with the Eagles Wings treasurer to discuss performing a financial review of our accounts for 2018.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u> – Steven made a motion for the Eagles Wings community to handle all the financial activity for Women's Walk EW 142, and on completion of the Walk we will split the expenses or profits. LeeLeen seconded, and the motion passed.

Steven will talk with Eagle's Wings Retreat Center for possible Walk dates for 2020, possibly May or September.

Mel will check on the Upper Room training sessions for the Board.

The next Board meeting will be July 11, 2019 at Northwest Hills UMC. There will also be a called meeting at Northwest Hills UMC on July 18, 2019 to discuss the 3-Day Schedule and how to adjust it for Eagle's Wings Retreat Center.

LeeLeen brought up discussion about articles for the WalkTalk. She will write the Lay Director article, and Harold will write an article.

Steven closed with prayer and the meeting adjourned at 8:19 p.m.
