# When to Ask for Support!

In the final moments of Jesus' life, he knew his death was imminent. What did he do? He asked for support. He asked Peter, James, and John to pray with him. And he prayed to God, from whom his help came. Do we know when to ask for the support we need, either from friends, from our pastors, or from God?

Emmaus is a spiritual-based community that gives lay leaders tools to be leaders in our churches. This, in turn, helps the pastor so they can lead their congregation to knowing Christ. A Walk cannot take place, nor even a team can be selected for the Walk, without the pastor. Just like Jesus, we, and I mean our Emmaus Community, need to ask for support from our pastor/spiritual leaders. When was the last time you heard your pastor talk about Emmaus from the pulpit? Or do you know if your pastor has been on a Walk? Without the support of our pastors/spiritual leaders, Emmaus will not be able to survive, and right now we are missing this vital part of the Emmaus Community.

It is heartwarming to see the pastors at Candlelight or at our Gatherings, and I know that it means a lot to the pilgrims that are on the Walk to look around and see their pastor there. With your help and support, we can get our pastors involved again.

I have written a letter addressed to the pastors about needing their support. The letter is in this issue of the *WalkTalk*, and I'm asking each of you to print it out and give it to your pastor to read. If our pastors receive multiple copies of this letter from the members of their congregations, they will know that it is important to keep Emmaus going and to support this community.

#### **RE:** Greater Austin Emmaus Community

Dear Pastor.

The Greater Austin Emmaus Community has had a long history of ministry in the greater Austin area for over 30 years. During this time, we have seen attendance at monthly Gatherings and participation in our Walks produce outstanding leaders in lay ministry for our area churches. We believe that this occurred through the encouragement of our area pastors, recognizing the importance of their participation. However, over the last several years we have seen a steady decline in participation in Emmaus by both lay people and clergy, and we are trying to discern why this is happening.

Emmaus has always been about the shared experience between clergy and laity to bring fellow Christians to a deeper understanding of the unconditional love of Jesus Christ. This is why it is imperative that our local Emmaus community have the support of the clergy. We only need to look at two of the nearby Emmaus communities, Hays Praise to the south and Soaring Eagles to the west, which have full Walks and monthly Gatherings, to see that the Emmaus movement is thriving in these areas. As large as the Austin area is, and with the number of churches in the area, we should not have any problems filling Walks, yet over the last two years we have had to cancel Walks due to a lack of pilgrims.

The Walk to Emmaus is a powerful tool which we, as members of the Board of Directors for the Greater Austin Emmaus Community, believe can start a revival for the local churches. We are asking for your support, and how we can support you, in encouraging participation in Emmaus.

- Could you wear your lanyard on the first Sunday of each month, attend Gatherings, and speak about the Walk to Emmaus from the pulpit?
- Could you help identify a passionate parishioner who could serve as the Point of Contact for your church to work with our Gathering Support Board Member?
- Can you provide the Board of Directors feedback regarding involvement for the Walk to Emmaus?

We believe God is moving us to evangelize the Walk to Emmaus movement in the Greater Austin Area, and we invite you to join us in this revival to spread the gospel in this community.

#### Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes October 3, 2019 Northwest Hills UMC

The meeting was called to order at 6:10 p.m. by LeeLeen Sundbeck, Acting Lay Director, who opened the meeting with prayer and presided over the meeting The following directors were present: LeeLeen Sundbeck, Acting Lay Director; Harold Sundbeck, Secretary; Mel Chambers, Upper Room Representative; Steven Scott, Gathering Support Coordinator; Jeanne Randall, Walk Support Coordinator, and Rev. Sylvester E. Chase, Jr., Spiritual Director. Coe Grace also attended the meeting.

QUORUM: Five Board members were present, providing a quorum for the meeting.

<u>MINUTES</u>: The Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes were sent by email for the previous meeting held on September 5, 2019. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved by email.

**REPORTS:** The following officers, directors, or other persons presented reports to the Board of Directors, with any items discussed or actions taken as noted below. The following items were discussed:

TREASURER'S REPORT - No report due to Patti Brizzell, Treasurer, being out of town.

<u>UPPER ROOM REPORT</u> – Mel reported Eban Files has agreed to serve as the Lay Director for Men's Walk #146 to be held February 20 – 23, 2020. Steven made the motion to approve Eban Files as Lay Director for Walk #146. Mel seconded the motion. All approved. The Board, along with Pastor Chase, will work with Eban to find a Spiritual Director for the Walk. Grady Rowe was suggested as a possible Spiritual Director.

Joel Roehling has agreed to serve as a Lay Director in 2022.

Mel reported the computer Patti brought to the last BOD meeting will meet our needs and made a motion to purchase the computer. Harold seconded the motion. All approved. Mel will talk to Bob Duplantis about acquiring the software we will need for use with the computer.

<u>GATHERING SUPPORT</u> – The next Gathering will be November 16<sup>th</sup> at Covenant UMC. Steven will lead the Agape Party at the Gathering. He is still working on music and a 4<sup>th</sup> day speaker.

The January Gathering will be at Wesley UMC on San Bernard Street.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u> – Steven reported that Eagles Wings community is interested in merging with the Greater Austin Emmaus Community, but we will need to have further discussions. Steven will try to set up a joint meeting over the next month.

Mel will take care of transferring our documents from Kristin Hampsten's Dropbox account into a new one for GAEC.

We will meet at 6:00 p.m. on October 10<sup>th</sup> at Northwest Hills UMC to continue our discussion of the 3-day schedule.

<u>OLD BUSINESS</u> – LeeLeen brought up discussion about articles for the *WalkTalk*. She will write the Lay Director article.

Pastor Chase closed the meeting with prayer and the meeting adjourned at 7:38 p.m.
