Jesus told us: I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. If you do not remain in me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. John 15:5-7

We can stay CONNECTED with each other, our Sunday school classes, and our reunion groups by phone, text, online software programs such as GoToMeeting, WebEx, and Google Meets, and by reading your MailChimp emails. #### One of My Fourth Day Experiences Also Known as a Closest to Christ Moment

Many of you know that my son Steven died last September. He was raised in the Christian faith, but he married Heather who does not believe there is a God. So, his life with her for almost 22 years did not include religion or spiritual thoughts or practices (at least not spoken). It was difficult for me, but I was mindful that they had a wonderful marriage and he was supportive of her scientific beliefs.

I spent much of the last two months of his life with him as he dealt with the cancer that was consuming his body. We talked about a lot of things, including where he would go next. He told me that he would be waiting for me at the Welcoming Center when it was my turn. That was a hopeful concept for me that he did still believe! As we neared the end of his journey, he kept telling me to "Find JOY in every day, Mom."

One of my very favorite Bible verses is James 1:2 which states, "My brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of any kind, consider it nothing but joy, because you know that the testing of your faith produces endurance; and let endurance have its full effect, so that you may be mature and complete, lacking in nothing."

I was standing in my garden a couple of weeks ago, trying to determine where I might place his memorial stone that is going to say, "Find JOY in every day." Suddenly, I remembered again that he DID still believe and that his connection with God was providing guidance for him and giving instruction for me. I felt such a sense of closeness to Christ that Steve's and my faith WAS being tested AND it provided the tools we both needed to endure.

Now WITH that endurance, I can feel the full effect of Christ's love as I continue my spiritual journey.

#### GAEC Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes April 4, 2020

The April Board Meeting was held by Zoom due to the current shelter-in-place directives to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Steven Scott as Acting Lay Director called the meeting to order at 4:05 p.m. and opened the meeting with a devotional and a prayer. The following directors were present: Acting Lay Director, Steven Scott; Past Lay Director, Fred Widmer; Secretary, Harold Sundbeck; Treasurer, Patti Bizzell; Upper Room Representative, Mel Chambers; Assistant Upper Room Representative, George Scherer; Communications, Lauren Moffatt; Gathering Support, Chuck Tencer; Walk Support (Sign-up/Trailer), Jeanne Randall; Assistant Walk Support (Agape), Jo Peters; Training, Nelda Carpenter; Database/Website, Rick Seifert; and Team Selection, Susan McMillian. QUORUM: Thirteen Board members were present, providing a quorum for the meeting.

MINUTES: The Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes were sent by email for the previous meeting held on March 7, 2020 and were approved by email.

GAEC BOARD DIRECTOR OFFICER ROLES: Steven presented a list of the GAEC Board of Directors with their positions and term dates.

<u>REPORTS</u> – The following officers, directors, or other persons presented reports to the Board of Directors, with any items discussed or actions taken as noted below. The following items were discussed:

<u>TREASURER'S REPORT</u> – Patti Bizzell reported the Frost Bank balance reconciles with the Aplos balance of \$16,132.95. Patti made the motion to accept the financial report; Mel Chambers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

<u>UPPER ROOM REPORT</u> – Mel Chambers reported he has the new Upper Room Covenant to be signed. He will send out by e-mail to be e-signed using Adobe. Mel also reported we have a trainer available for Clergy Training when needed. Mel will send on-line info to Nelda to attend on-line training to be a trainer for Walks.

<u>COMMUNICATIONS SUPPORT</u> – Lauren Moffatt reported that all e-mails from the database have been added to MailChimp for our future email distribution to the community. Our distribution list is now approximately 3,100 addresses.

<u>WALK SUPPORT</u> – Jeanne Randall reported she will be sending out links to end the sign-ups for the Agape and Prayer Vigils for Women's Walk #147 since it has been re-scheduled.

<u>GATHERING SUPPORT</u> – The May Gathering is canceled due to the on-going shelter-in-place restrictions; however, we hope to hold a Gathering in June. The tentative Gathering will be held June 6<sup>th</sup> at Round Rock Presbyterian Church. A final decision will be made at our May Board meeting.

<u>TRAINING</u> – Steven asked the Board members to offer suggestions for a couple of the community members to serve as volunteers on the Team Selection committee.

<u>DATABASE/WEBSITE SUPPORT</u> – Verve and Go Daddy hosting sites have been paid. Rick will head a sub-committee to work on updating the website. Lauren Moffatt, Steven Scott, Fred Widmer, and Eric Bursley will also serve on the committee.

WALK #147 LAY DIRECTOR REPORT – The May 14-17 dates have been re-scheduled to July 30 – August 2, 2020.

WALK #148 LAY DIRECTOR REPORT – A date for Team selection will be set at our May meeting.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u> – Board meeting dates are set through November. Our next meeting date will be May 2, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. via Zoom. We also need to make a couple of changes to our By-Laws that will be addressed at our May Board meeting. Steven will finish up the update on the job descriptions.

<u>OLD BUSINESS</u> – Rick to finalize Eagles Wings reconciliation of the bank account and work on dissolving the Eagles Wings community.

<u>WALKTALK ARTICLES</u> – Steven will write the Lay Director report for the <u>WalkTalk</u>. Jeanne Randall will submit an article about Agape for the June <u>WalkTalk</u>.

Rick Seifert closed the meeting with prayer and the meeting adjourned at 5:35 p.m.
